

From 06.06. to 20.06.2009, we spent a fantastic holiday at holiday home Villa Nelli in Scario/Cilento.

Villa Nelli was not our first choice, but in retrospect it was surely the best. The home is ideal for 2 persons, has good furnishing, a great terrace with adequate furnishing, a charming garden with view of the bay of Policastro.

Furthermore, we found, during our excursions, that the small town of Scario pleases us most by far. Illuminated in the evenings, the harbour is very romantic. We also enjoyed a good meal at the La Pietra, on the road to San Giovanni a Piero and at the restaurant U` Trappitu at Acquavena.

We recommend excursions to:

- Rivello, is located in the mountains and has been declared a national monument due to its fantastic location.
- Along the dream of a coastal road not to be described in words to Maratea; here, in any case, up to Cristo de Maratea. The road per se is an experience.
- Via the highway to the World Heritage Site of Paestum. If there is enough time left, drive back slowly to Scario via the coastal road.
- The small town of Marina di Camerota is nice, too. Here, it is really worth while making a boat tour with the Cooperativa Cilento Mare along the coast of Infreschi with its numerous grottos and bathing bays.
- We discovered the most beautiful and practical beach for us shortly behind Marina di Camerota.

It was, however, nicest at Scario, sitting at the Lungomare enjoying a good meal and, of course, an adequate glass of wine or in the afternoon at "Toni"'s, sipping an espresso, an aperitif or whatever pleases you, and enjoying your holiday in Italy.

Long-time devotees of Italy holidays, we need to mention that the people here in the south were very kind and friendly.
